Industries With Growth Potential

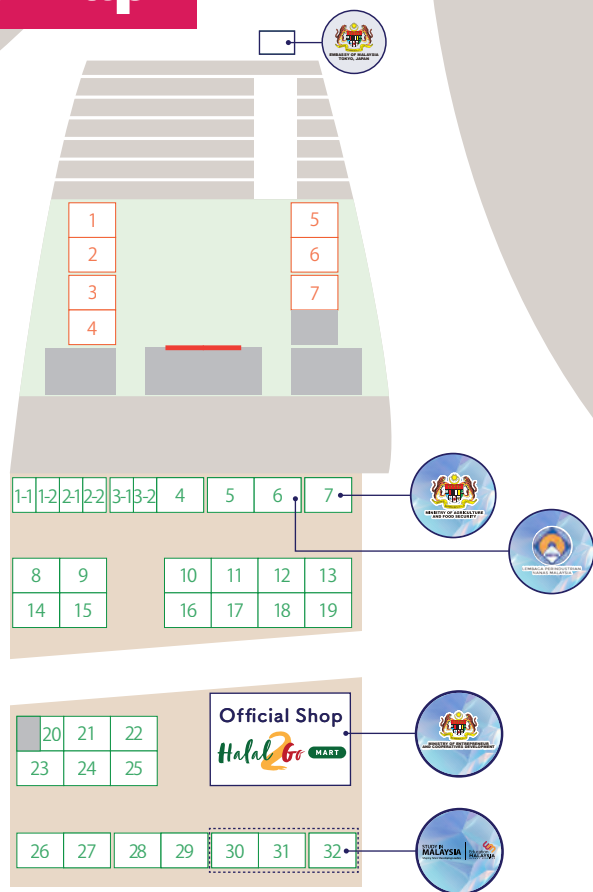
